I am truly delighted to be welcoming you to what I'm confident is going to be an incredible experience.

Setting up my own Orchestra and Choir has been a dream for nearly 30 years and largely thanks to COVID I've been able to realise it! I didn't just wake up one morning and say to myself "I'm going to start a musical venture tomorrow" and book a venue. A lot of time has been put into this; planning, scheduling, arranging, orchestrating, advertising, finding venues to rehearse and perform, deciding on a program of concerts that will excite me, the performers and the audience.

Our first concert is Mozart's Requiem in D Minor and this will be performed on Saturday November 13th at St. John's Church in Pewsey. Whilst we will normally charge for admission, as this is our first concert - and only an hour long - I've decided that it'll be entry by donation only. Following this concert, on Sunday December 19th at the Bouverie Hall we will have our Christmas Concert. This will be an early evening concert.

Please note on the day of the concert there will be a rehearsal in the afternoon with everyone, in the venue we're performing in.

# Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs Terms And Conditions

- 1. The sum of £60 per term is to be paid at the first session you attend.
  - i. This sum can be paid in 3 instalments if necessary.
  - ii. By paying in instalments you agree to pay the full term amount, even if you decide to leave before the end of the term.
- 2. A term is always a minimum of 12 weeks, very often it's longer.
  - i. Where possible we will take half term off. This is in addition to the 12 weeks minimum term.
- 3. Members are expected to attend as many rehearsals as possible. The ethos of the orchestra is to make music together.
- 4. Absence from the rehearsals does not infer entitlement to a discount.
- 5. Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs will operate, as far as possible, a COVID safe environment.
  - i. Temperatures will be taken as you enter the rehearsal/performance venue.
  - ii. Sanitising gel and anti-bacterial wipes will be made available.
  - iii. It would be appreciated if a Lateral Flow Test, or equivalent, is taken the morning of the rehearsal or performance. If a positive result is given then you are not to attend.
  - iv. If you don't have a COVID test, but show symptoms of COVID (high temperature, loss of taste, loss of smell) please do not attend.
  - v. Face masks are optional.
  - vi. You are to bring your own music stand.
  - vii. You will also sign a declaration that states that you are, to the best of your knowledge, free from COVID symptoms.
- 6. All members shall be covered on the Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs Liability Insurance whilst in the care of Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs.
  - i. Members are not covered if not participating in a Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs activity (practising at home doesn't count!).
- 7. All staff of Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs will have Enhanced CRB disclosure.
- 8. Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs will put on at least one concert per term.
  - i. Members will be expected to actively promote the concerts in an enthusiastic and positive manner.
- 9. Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs will make the rehearsals a safe space for learning and developing.
- 10. Stand Sure Orchestra & Choirs will operate on a basis of mutual respect from everyone. Everyone will be treated equally. There are no stars of the show!
